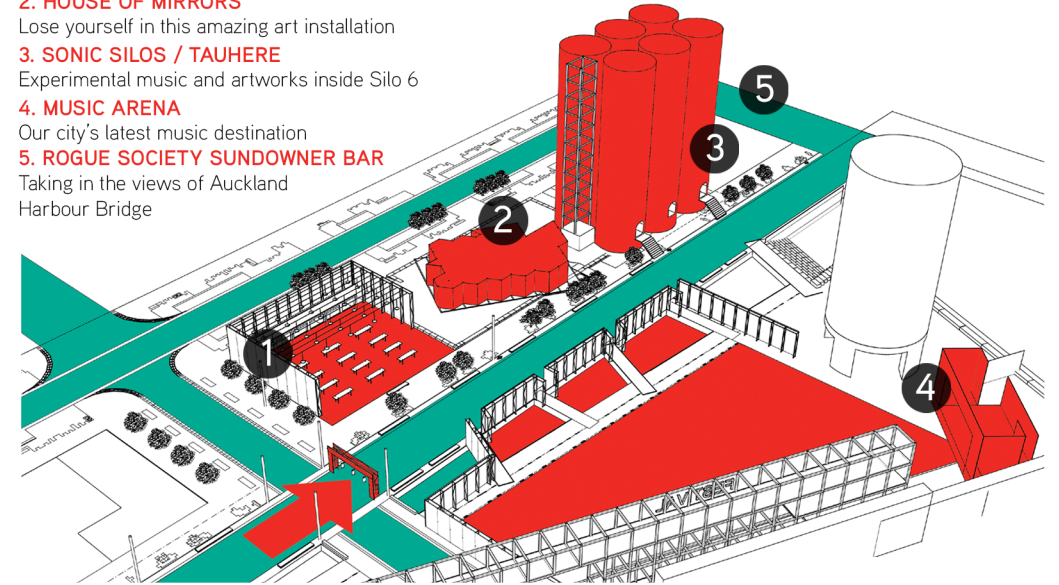

ENTRY

Entry to the Festival Playground site is FREE. Tickets are required for ticketed shows in the Music Arena and for House of Mirrors. The Festival Playground is open to all ages at all operational times. All Music Arena shows take place rain, hail or shine on a grassed area. Terms and conditions apply for entry. Visit the website for details.

ACCESSIBILITY

The Festival Playground is wheelchair accessible with ramps providing access to House of Mirrors and Silo 6. Accessible drop off/pick-up is point on the corner of Jellicoe and Hamer Sts. A designated viewing area is located in the Music Arena for patrons who have specific accessibility requirements. Please note: The grassed area in the Music Arena can be uneven. Accessible toilets are available in the Festival Playground and Music Arena.

The Festival Playground is presented as part of Auckland Arts Festival 2018 which features more than 50 shows and events in Auckland during March.
